ASSIGNMENT FOR *FAHRENHEIT 451*:

You can either save a copy of the Reading Guide in your Google Drive, or you can download it as a Word document and save it to your computer.

- **To save it to your Google Drive:** Click “File” at the top of the document page, then select “Make a Copy.” It will prompt you to save it to your Google Drive.
- **To download it as a Word document:** Click “File” at the top of the document page, select “Download,” and then select “Word Document.”

ASSIGNMENT FOR *ANIMAL FARM*:

After reading the book, compose a five paragraph essay that analyzes one character from the story. Use the following outline to organize your essay.

- I. Introduction (3-5 sentences): gives the name of the book, the author’s name, and a summary of the book
- II. Body paragraph that describes the character / character traits (5-7 sentences)
- III. Body paragraph that explains what motivates this character to behave the way he/she behaves (5-7 sentences)
- IV. Body paragraph that describes one or more conflicts that this character faces and how the conflicts are resolved (5-7 sentences)
- V. Conclusion (3-5 sentences): discuss a lesson the character teaches the reader and wrap up the essay

Teachers may also require a hard copy to be turned in along with the electronic copy.

Assignments will be submitted to *Turnitin.com*, a plagiarism checking program, when school starts. These are to be your original work. Any work that is plagiarized, copied and pasted, and/or is not original will not be accepted.
