Additional documents that must be submitted before the application may be processed.

1. Most recent standardized test scores in English/Reading & Math.

Current Caddo public student: Current 8th graders are required to have scores of 730 in English **AND** Math on the **7th grade LEAP exam** or 8th Grade **PreACT scores of English-13 or Reading-17 AND Math-16 or above.**Scores may be printed from JCampus. Scores showing a 50th percentile or higher on a nationally recognized standardized exam in English/Reading **AND** Math may also be used.

<u>Private/ out-of-district students</u>: Scores in the 50th percentile or higher in English/Reading **AND** Math on a nationally recognized standardized test (Stanford, Terra Nova, ACT, PSAT, SAT, Iowa, ERB, etc.)

Students who do not have scores to submit, or do not have a qualifying score in either subject area, should contact Mrs. Janet Wheat at 318-364-5074 or jwheat@caddoschools.org for instructions on how to test.

Copy of the most recent report card showing a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

(Cumulative refers to an average of all grades for each grading period)

<u>Current Caddo public student:</u> Copy of the printed report card is preferred and not the JCampus printout, but the JCampus version will be accepted.

3. Printed attendance and discipline record. Attendance record should reflect 95% or higher attendance rate and will be reviewed for absences, check-outs, check-ins, and tardies. The discipline record should be exemplary with no out-of-school suspensions. Any detentions and/or in-school suspensions will be carefully reviewed.

<u>Current Caddo public student:</u> These may be printed from JCampus. If there are no discipline entries, still submit the paper that states "No items to show."

<u>Private / out-of-district students:</u> Submit a letter from a school administrator verifying attendance history, that includes the number of absences and tardies, and a detailed discipline record. If there is no discipline record, it should be stated such as "no discipline record, none," etc.

- 4. Proof of Caddo Parish residency in parent(s)/guardian(s) name(s): utility bill (gas, water, electric) or current lease. If you and your student reside with someone else, you must provide a notarized letter of affidavit to this effect along with a copy of a utility bill in that person's name. This must be turned in with application.
- **5.** Complete record of grades earned for high school credit (the most current transcript) indicating a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a weighted scale. Students applying for 10th or 11th grade must submit a withdrawal form from the previous high school by May 29, 2026.
- 6. Louisiana students will need to submit any LEAP 2025 (high school credit) exam results with a score of Basic or higher on any exams the student has taken (Algebra I, Geometry, English I, English II, Biology, American History).
- 7. Students NOT currently enrolled in a Caddo Parish public school must also submit the following:

 Copy of student's birth certificate, social security card, and up-to-date immunization record.

Admission will be finalized, and students will be registered for the 2026-27 school year after the following two items are submitted at a later date. Instructions will be given to those students that are provisionally accepted.

- Final report card indicating a 2.5 cumulative GPA for the current school year AND transcript of complete record of high school credits.
- Promotion to high school as a full 9th grade student or on track for graduation without the need for credit recovery courses if applying for 10th or 11th grade.

Completed applications and ALL required forms may be delivered to the school by the following methods:

- > If you would like someone to go through the packet with you, visit the main office between 8:00-4:00 Monday-Friday.
- Mail the packet to Caddo Magnet High School at the address printed on the front of this form.

The deadline to guarantee admittance if the student meets all qualifications is February 6th. Incoming classes are limited to approximately 300 students. Applications received after this date will be placed on a waiting list.
